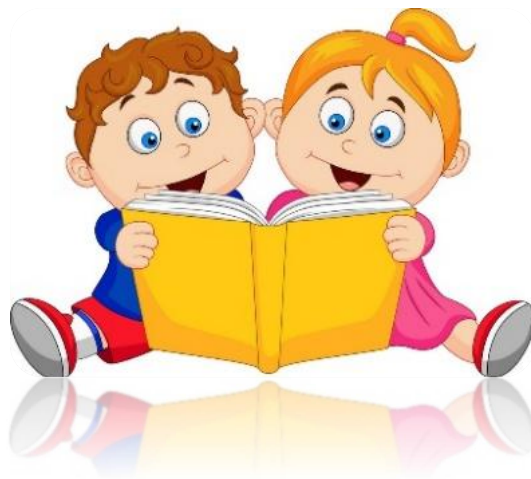

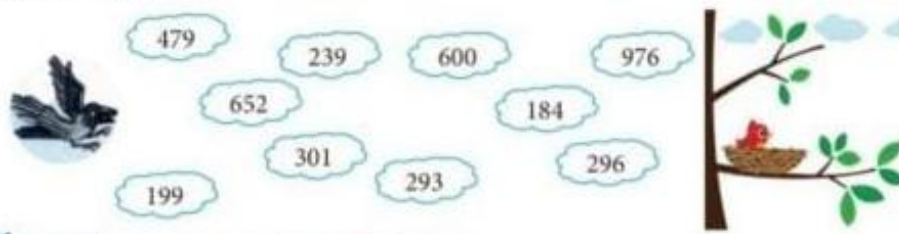

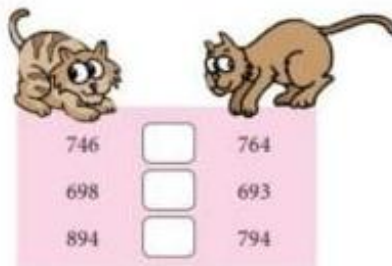
★ Colour the clouds having numbers greater than 300 and join them to help the bird reach its nest.
