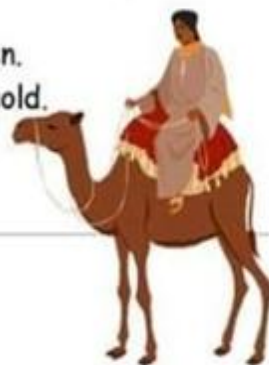
"Master my back legs are cold. Please move into the corner so that I can get them in." The man moved and the camel came in. Now, there was no room in the tent at all.
